

Holmdel Municipal Court Adjournment Policy

Any case less than 30 days from the issue date will receive ONE adjournment for any reason with supporting documents.

Cases between 30 and 60 days old MUST submit their adjournment request in writing accompanied by supporting documents at least 7 days prior to the scheduled court date if there is an involved party, 4 days prior if not.

No adjournments will be granted for any reason during the week of the scheduled court session.

Discovery requests must be made in the courtroom to the Municipal Court Judge during a scheduled court session for any cases 30 days or older from the date of issue.

Emergent requests due to illness, accident or other unanticipated events shall be granted only if supporting proofs are supplied to the court.

Adjournments are not to be considered granted unless confirmed with court staff.
